Title of Bill: Gay Marriage and Benefits

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS

Preamble: As of today there are 6 out of the 50 states (MA, CT, IA, VT, ME, NH) in the America that allow same sex couples to marry.

Heterosexual couples who marry are offered over 1,400 benefits.

Homosexual couples who are denied the right of marriage in 44 of the 50 states are also denied of these benefits.

Section 1: No state shall deny marriage of any person as long they are of proper age of 18 and do not break any laws of incest.

Section 2: No state can discriminate against same sex marriage, nor can they make statute against it.

Section 3: No married couple shall be denied of any marriage benefits in any state regardless of sex.

Section 4: All married couples including same sex, should be equally considered for child adoption as long as minimum criteria is met.

Enactment Clause: This bill will come into effect 60 days after passage.
