Title of Bill: Decriminalization of Cannabis

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS

1 PREAMBLE: Whereas twenty one of fifty states have decriminalized non-medical
2 cannabis use, where as about one out of every six federal inmates is in federal prison for
3 marijuana thus tying up millions of dollars, whereas alcohol and tobacco have been
4 legalized, taxed and regulated, whereas extensive studies regarding side-effects, both long
5 term short term benefits and consequences, have been conducted, and since non-medical
6 cannabis use is illegal under federal law,

8 SECTION I: Let cannabis be decriminalized under federal law

10 SECTION II: Let cannabis be subject to the free market economy, regulated as illicit
11 commodities of the past have been

12 Sub-Section A: Let the private growth of cannabis be decriminalized

13 Sub-Section B: Let the private sale of cannabis as detailed in Sub-Section II be illegal
14 without proper state licensing

16 SECTION III: Operation of motor vehicles or heavy machinery under the influence of
17 cannabis will be punishable by state laws

19 SECTION IV: This bill shall go into effect 90 days after its passage.
